Whether you're interested in our Doggy Daycare or Boarding service, here at Newcastle Pet Resort ALL pups become part of our daily Doggy Play program. This isn't just playtime - it's our "PLAY. STAY. LEARN." methodology that creates confident, balanced pups that families can take anywhere.

What makes us different? We don't just want to take your money. We want to ensure that you, your pup, and your family are living a balanced life, a happy life. We become family based on our conversations about our pups, our genuine interest and love for your fur baby.

Our Unique Assessment Process - Your Pup's First Day

All pups must attend a Facility Entrance Assessment day to ensure safety for them and their new friends. Our experienced Canine Carers assess your pup using our "Traffic Management Signals" system:

- GREEN means "Go" your pup thrives in our environment
- YELLOW means "Go Slow" your pup is suitable but needs guidance in some areas (we work together.
- **RED** means "Stop" we'll refer you to specialists who can help your pup's social journey

Remember: Not all dogs are social with other dogs, and that's perfectly okay! We want to be honest with you about what's best for your fur baby.

24-Hour Bookings

If your pup is staying for ONE night ONLY and you pick up within 24 hours of drop-off, you'll only be charged the one-day boarding rate. We keep it simple!

Our Family Agreement - Being Honest With You

We believe in transparency because #trust is one of our core values.

What We Need From You:

- Current C5 Vaccination: Your pup must have up-to-date vaccinations
- Desexing: Pups over 12 months must be desexed (if not, an extra charge of \$11 per day will be charged)
- Health Check: We need to know your pup hasn't been unwell in the past 30 days
- Honesty About Behavior: Please tell us about any behavioural concerns we're here to help, not judge!
- Lead Policy: Your pup must enter and leave on a lead (for everyone's safety)

What You Can Expect From Us:

- Maximum Supervision: Our qualified Canine Carers watch every interaction
- **Immediate Care:** If your pup needs medical attention, we'll provide first aid and contact you immediately
- Gentle Guidance: We may use balanced behaviour techniques to keep everyone safe and happy
- Daily Updates: Pictures that tell a thousand words you'll see your pup having the time of their life!

Being Honest About Risks:

Our play yard is much like a schoolyard - things can happen. We want you to understand the inherent risks:

- Transfer of communicable illnesses (like Dog Flu)
- Minor injuries (cuts, scrapes, sore pads)
- Behavioural adjustments as pups learn social skills

Our Promise: In 16+ years, we've only had to send two pups home because they didn't cope in our environment. We'll always be honest with you about what's best for your fur baby.

Payment & Cancellations:

- Payment: Due on arrival (payment details can be found at the bottom of our Invoices)
- Cancellations: 24 hours notice required via email (\$30 cancellation fee if notice is not given)
- Peak Period Cancellations: 14 days notice required via email (check our website for dates)
- Late Pickup: \$50 every 20 minutes (we have families to get home to too!)

Understanding Dog Flu - We Want You to Know

Your pup's health & safety is our #1 priority (#poochpriority)

Here's what we want you to know about Dog Flu, because being informed helps you help your pup:

What Is Dog Flu?

Dog Flu (infectious tracheobronchitis) is like the common cold for humans - highly contagious and spread through the air. The main symptom is a gagging cough that can last from a few days to several weeks.

Here's What We've Learned in 16+ Years:

- It's Everywhere: These viruses can affect any dog, even those who never leave their backyard
- It's Seasonal: Like human flu, it tends to come in waves
- Most Pups Recover Well: Just like humans with a cold, most pups get through it fine with proper care / rest
- **Prevention Helps:** The C5 vaccination provides good (but not 100%) protection

Our Safety Measures:

- Strict daily cleaning with veterinary-grade disinfectants
- Isolation area for any pup who needs extra care
- Immediate notification if we see any symptoms
- Partnership with trusted local vets

If Your Pup Gets Sick:

We'll contact you immediately and work with your vet to ensure your fur baby gets the best care. Any veterinary expenses are your responsibility, but we'll be with you every step of the way.
